I also wanted to highlight a couple of special events that are coming up in December. First there is the Country Estates Park Trails Grand Opening and hog roast on Saturday, December 5th, from 11:00 AM to 3:00 PM. The Country Estates Park officially opened over the summer. Believe it or not it has been fifteen years since we made the decision to form our Town in 2000. At

that time all of the area from US 27 east to Flamingo Road was still part of Broward County and we were governed by Broward County. We decided to become our own Town, the leader of that movement was one of the residents Mecca Fink who started all the paper work to make that happen and was successful. We had meetings to decide what we were to call our Town and because we were as far as you could go west we decided to name it Southwest Ranches representing our lifestyle which was rural and animal friendly which we were. We filed all the paperwork to have our own election and in 2000 we held our first election. Mecca was elected as our first Mayor, Johnnie Dollar Vice Mayor, Forest Blanton, Astor Knight and myself as Council members. Through all this paper work we were very fortunate to have an attorney living in our Town, Gary Poliakoff. Gary did all the necessary paper work and let us set up a temporary office in his building on Stirling Road. At that time Weston was being developed and had set up temporary quarters in portable buildings. When they built their own offices they were getting rid of the temporary buildings and we were able to obtain one of them which we had set up on property which was owned by the South Broward Drainage District on Dykes Road, and with the help of many volunteers we were able to turn them into our first Town Hall where we stayed until we were able to purchase our own building at 13400 Griffin Road. In this building we have all our offices which holds our Town Administor, his staff and our Town Attorney and other offices we need.

To celebrate our birthday we had a birthday party on Saturday November 7, 2015 where the volunteer fire members cooked the food which was very delicious. I hoped you were able to be there if you missed it you missed a good time.



IN LOVING MEMORY BILL FETTERS

Bill Fetters, longtime resident of Rolling Oaks, lived life with a passion—for his family, his Great Danes and community service. He passed away Oct. 10, following a massive stroke.



Bill was born in Dover, Ohio on Dec. 4, 1934. He met his true love, Sandi, at an early age while they were attending Dover Jr. High School. Bill was in the eighth grade and Sandi in the seventh. "I knew from the start that what I wanted was Bill," says Sandi.

While serving in the U.S. Navy for four years, he became a member of the elite Atlantic Fleet Pistol Championship Team.

The couple were married in 1958 in Dover. That same year Bill bought his first Great Dane, put it in the back of the car and drove to Florida.

The couple have a daughter, Tari, born in 1960. When their daughter, Julie, born in 1962, passed away in 1997, Bill and Sandi took her son, Cole and raised him.

In 1977, the couple moved to Southwest Ranches and purchased five acres in Rolling Oaks. He and his father-in-law, Dan Krantz, owned and operated K&F General Maintenance Service Station in Hollywood for 47 years.

The Fetters and their granddaughter, Jennifer Dachton, who has lived with them since she was 13, have been breeding and showing Great Danes and were named the top winning Great Dane breeders in the U.S. and 16 countries. Also they showed Saddlebreds, raced Thoroughbreds, and Bill was an active member of Citizens on Patrol.

In addition to his wife, Sandi, Bill is survived by his daughter, Tari Dachton; grand-daughter Jennifer; grandsons Chance Dachton and Cole Sisler; and Jennifer's fiancé, Brian Schick.

For the month of September there were a total of 79 calls in the Town. Forty -eight of these calls were medical.


