Call to order at 7:00pm. A quorum was established.

Priscilla Prado-Stroze motioned to keep the officer positions from the 2021 year. Selena Hodgers seconded, and the motion carried.

Discussion Items:

- Debbie Green gave the treasurer's report: \$11,690 has come in for this year's flocking. This is not as much as last year...we will just do this for the month of March. Signage should face the roadway not the houses. \$2,750 came in for the barn dance, \$200 for the Cow Pie Bingo, SRHOA has donated a total of \$2,500. Monies thus far equal \$29,426. Next month's meeting will determine the scholarship allocations.
- 93 people have confirmed for the dance (almost all are paid)...eleven tables are inside with two outside. The silent auction will be held inside (as it was two years ago). Priscilla has signed paraphernalia, we also have bags, oils, photo session, kids' fishing experience, 65 bags of mulch, guitars, Disney Resort, autographed football and prints, baskets via Councilman Jablonski, wine from Attorney Poliakoff, and gift cards. The list of guests was reviewed. Tuesday and Wednesday will begin set-up and decorating for Saturday. 11 AM Saturday will be the evening's prep. We should be at the Barn by 6 PM. Selena has completed the inventory and Leah has purchased necessities. Selena will supervise the bar area. Volunteer Morales will manage the kitchen appetizer distribution. The chili wagon is open to folks all evening. Outback is providing the lemonade, tea (we will have pitchers of both at each table), steak, chicken, potatoes, asparagus, salad, bread, and butter. Debbie will assist with auction win distribution. On Wednesday evening, there will be a line dancing class at 7 PM (at the Barn).
- The Sikh's have created teams for all schools. Flyers, specific to schools, have been sent; these include school specific QR codes. The run begins at the Barn, runs to the end of 172nd, then returns. Runners will keep to one lane.
