Debbie Green motioned to accept the minutes from October 24, 2022. Page Giacin seconded. The motion carried.

Debbie Green motioned to remove the "Letter of Recommendation" requirement from the 2023 SEAB scholarship application. Francesca Case seconded. The motion carried.

## Discussion Items:

- Debbie Green gave the treasurer's report: \$8,178.38 is in the account. The amount includes a \$1500 donation from Sunshine Ranches HOA and a \$500 donation from the family of Vince Falletta.
- The Board discussed new guidelines for earned volunteer hours. The following recommendations were suggested:

  - 5. Describe how living in Southwest Ranches has impacted your life?
- The Board discussed removing the "Letter of Recommendation" requirement from the scholarship application.

- The Board recommended that the scholarship application be a fillable pdf document on the Town's website.
- The Board set the calendar for the following upcoming events:
