## **RESOLUTION NO. 2002-6**

A RESOULTION OF THE TOWN OF SOUTHWEST RANCHES, FLORIDA REQUESTING BROWARD COUNTY TO DONATE SIXTY-EIGHT THOUSAND (68,000) CUBIC YARDS OF FILL THAT COUNTY INTENDS TO DECLARE SURPLUS PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, the County has declared Sixty-eight Thousand (68,000) cubic yards of fill as surplus property from the Long Pine Key Natural Area and said fill is not needed at any other County site; and

WHEREAS, the Town has requested that the County donate this fill for the development of the Sunshine Ranches Equestrian Park Site; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 274.06, Florida Statutes, the County is authorized to declare such fill surplus property and make such a donation; and

WHEREAS, it is determined to be in the best interest of the County to dispose of the surplus fill by donation to the Town of Southwest Ranches and that this donation serves a public purpose and promotes community interest and welfare.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Town Council of the Town of Southwest Ranches, Florida:

Section 1: The recitals set forth in the preamble to this Resolution are incorporated by reference herein.

Section 2: The Town agrees that the requested sixty- eight thousand (68,000) cubic yards of fill shall be used as follows:

- a. Town agrees that the fill material shall be used exclusively for and remain at the designated Sunshine Ranches Equestrian Park, a neighborhood park site.
- b. Town agrees to monitor any hauling contractor and certify to County that only sixty-eight thousand (68,000) cubic yards of loose, uncompacted fill material has been removed from the County site and hauled to the designated site only.
- c. Town agrees that any hauling activities must be completed within One Hundred Eighty (180) days of execution of the County's donation Resolution.
- d. Town agrees to be responsible for acquiring any and all required permits for the hauling of the fill material and for the payment of any associated costs and fees.

Section 3: This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption
