

RESOLUTION No. 2002 - 19

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF SOUTHWEST RANCHES, FLORIDA, URGING THE BROWARD COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD TO ENHANCE THE QUALITY OF EDUCATION WITHIN BROWARD COUNTY AND SUPPORT THOSE OPTIONS THAT MAINTAIN THE INTEGRITY OF CLEAN FEEDER PATTERNS, MAINTAINING HAWKES BLUFF AND FALCON COVE FEEDER PATTERNS TO HHH HIGH SCHOOL AND FURTHERMORE URGE THE BROWARD COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD TO CREATIVELY DEVELOP NEW SCHOOL FACILITIES TO MEET THE NEEDS OF THE RESIDENTS OF BROWARD COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the availability of appropriately sized school facilities provide important benefits to the quality of life of the Town of Southwest Ranches and all of Broward County; and,

WHEREAS, the education of our children provides for the foundation for the future of our community, and,

WHEREAS, the location of school facilities needs to meet the profile of the children in the community, and,


WHEREAS, the school boundaries need to address the accessibility of the school facilities in relationship to the children being served, and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Southwest Ranches, Florida, as follows:

Section 1: The Town Council of the Town of Southwest Ranches urges the Broward County School Board to support those options that maintain the integrity of clean feeder patterns, maintaining Hawkes Bluff and Falcon Cove feeder patterns to HHH High School; and

Section 2: The Town Council of the Town of Southwest Ranches urges the Broward County School Board to vigorously pursue all possibilities in the development of school facilities to meet the needs of the residents of Broward County.
