

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SOUTHWEST RANCHES, FLORIDA EXPANDING THE SCOPE OF THE FRIENDS OF PARKS ADVISORY BOARD TO PROVIDE INPUT INTO THE TOWN'S MULTI-PURPOSE TRAILS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, at the December 11, 2003 Town Council Meeting, the Town Council approved Resolution 2004-20, which established the Friends of Parks Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, the Council created the Board to provide input into the coordination of plans for the acquisition, funding, design, development, operation, maintenance and regulation of parks within the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to expand the scope of the Board to provide input into the Town's multi-purpose trails.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Southwest Ranches, Florida:

Section 1: The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: The Town Council hereby expands the scope of the Friends of the Parks Advisory Board to provide input into the Town's multi-purpose trails.

Section 3: This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
