RESOLUTION NO. 2008 - 039

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SOUTHWEST RANCHES, FLORIDA, RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THAT THE SCHOOL BOARD OF BROWARD COUNTY ADOPT HIGH SCHOOL BOUNDARY SCENARIO 4.3 PROVIDED THAT THOSE SOUTHWEST RANCHES STUDENTS CURRENTLY ENROLLED AT CYPRESS BAY HIGH SCHOOL ARE GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO FINISH HIGH SCHOOL AT CYPRESS BAY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town's main high school, Cypress Bay, is the most overcrowded high school in the nation with an enrollment of over 5,300 students; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide relief for the extensive overcrowding, the School Board of Broward County is considering multiple boundary change scenarios; and

WHEREAS, the School Board of Broward County has requested feedback from the parties involved; and

WHEREAS, on January 22, 2008 the School Board of Broward County hosted a workshop where it identified and presented Boundary Scenario 4.3; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide continuity and fairness, the Town respectfully requests that these proposed boundary scenarios not affect those Southwest Ranches students currently enrolled in Cypress Bay High School; and

WHEREAS, provided that those Southwest Ranches students currently enrolled at Cypress Bay are given the opportunity to finish high school at Cypress Bay, then the Town feels that Boundary Scenario 4.3 would best boundary option; and

WHEREAS, Boundary Scenario 4.3 supports the safety and welfare of the children of Southwest Ranches by not forcing them to travel on US-27 to attend the only other nearby high school, West Broward High School; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Southwest Ranches has determined that High School Boundary Scenario 4.3 is the most equitable and safest of all the scenarios thus far presented by the School Board of Broward County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Southwest Ranches, Florida:

Section 1. The above reference recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Town Council hereby respectfully requests that the School Board of Broward County adopt high school scenario 4.3, as generated from the January 22, 2008 Board workshop and attached hereto as Exhibit "A", provided that those Southwest Ranches students currently enrolled at Cypress Bay High School are given the opportunity to finish high school at Cypress Bay.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.



This scenario recommends moving a portion of Cypress Bay and Everglades to West Broward High School (LLL) to establish the attendance area for West Broward High School (LLL). This scenario phases-in a portion of Flanagan, Charles W. to West Broward High School (LLL) with 9th grade in 2008-09 followed by 9th and 10th grades in 2009-10, 9th through 11th grades in 2010-11, and 9th through 12th grades in 2011-12. This scenario also moves a portion of Cypress Bay High School to Western and Cooper City High Schools, a portion of Miramar High School to Everglades High School, and McArthur High School to Flanagan, Charles W. High School.

2008-09: 4,626 is over gross capacity on main campus by 42; main campus can absorb overage.

*Remember - Cypress Bay High School class size analysis reports a need of 15 classrooms beyond the current 6,000 capacity high school even though student enrollment is 5,501. Projected enrollment numbers near the maximum capacity of the main campus gross capacity (4,584) may jeopardize the ability to neet class size targets.

Students in close proximity to Cypress Bay High School remain at Cypress Bay High School.

Splits the 100% feeder pattern of Falcon Cove Middle School between Cypress Bay High School and West Broward (LLL), Glades Middle School feeder between Everglades High School and West Broward (LLL), New Renaissance Middle School feeder between Miramar and Everglades High Schools, and Walter C. Young feeder between Everglades and Flanagan, Charles W. High Schools.
Silver Trail Middle School feeder would split between three high schools; Cooper City, Cypress Bay, and West Broward (LLL).
