

RESOLUTION NO. 2008 – 076

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SOUTHWEST RANCHES, FLORIDA PIGGY-BACKING ONTO THE EXISTING CONTRACT ENTERED INTO BY THE CITY OF PLANTATION, FLORIDA WITH CHARLIE FRYMYER PAVING, INC. FOR PAVING AND SITE IMPROVEMENT SERVICES AT THE TEMPORARY FIRE STATION SITE; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, TOWN ADMINISTRATOR, AND TOWN ATTORNEY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CHARLIE FRYMYER PAVING, INC. FOR PAVING AND SITE IMPROVEMENT SERVICES AT THE TEMPORARY FIRE STATION SITE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town is currently planning to construct a temporary Fire Station on the northwest corner of SW 172nd Avenue and SW 46th Street; and

WHEREAS, this site is in need of Paving and Site Improvements before such construction can begin; and

WHEREAS, the City of Plantation has recently issued a competitive procurement to find qualified vendors to provide Paving and Site Improvement Services; and

WHEREAS, on April 16, 2008, after careful review of the proposals received, the City of Plantation awarded a purchase order to Charlie Frymyer Paving, Inc. for the provision of Paving and Site Improvement Services; and

WHEREAS, the Town desires to piggy-back onto the City of Plantation's Agreement with Charlie Frymyer Paving, Inc. to provide the necessary Paving and Site Improvements relating to the temporary Fire Station site.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Southwest Ranches, Florida:

Section 1. The above referenced recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: The Town Council of the Town of Southwest Ranches hereby agrees to piggy-back onto the Agreement between the City of Plantation and Charlie Frymyer Paving, Inc. for the provision of necessary Paving and Site

Improvement Services at the temporary Fire Station site, as delineated in "Exhibit A".







LOCATION MAP







GENERAL NOTES

3. Prior to construction, property owner shall file a "Site Improvement Application" with the Town of Southwest Ranches. This application shall include a detailed site plan, engineering calculations, and any other information required by the Town of Southwest Ranches.
4. No permit is required to construct a single-family residence.
5. No permit is required to construct a townhouse or condominium.
6. No permit is required to construct a mobile home.
7. The "Town of Southwest Ranches Residential Construction Standards" shall apply to all new residential construction.
8. Permits may be required for certain types of structures.
9. General Building Code and Florida Residential Code apply.
10. Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) regulations apply.
11. Stormwater Management regulations apply.
12. Water and Sewer connections shall be made to the existing utility lines.
13. Construction shall be limited to areas where no utility lines exist.











RECOMMENDED SPACING FOR BALED HAY BARRIERS AND TYPE III SILT FENCE

SILT FENCE APPLICATIONS





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
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
LAKE OUTFALL DETAIL WITHOUT HEADWALL



POLLUTION RETARDANT BAFFLE DETAIL




EXFILTRATION TRENCH DETAIL




LAKE/CANAL INTERCONNECT BASIN AND MANHOLE


PRIMARY CANAL DESIGN SECTION AND CANAL MAINTENANCE EASEMENT

The Central Water Treatment Plant houses on a daily basis the department's purchasing division personnel, water plant operations personnel and now includes the new Utilities Operations Center's personnel, consisting of a large number of field service employees, for the department. The increase in both City vehicles and personal vehicles needing to park on the plant site has outgrown the original 1989 parking design for the plant.

A design has been approved to improve the parking lot size and striping needs at the plant. This work was posted on the City's Demand Star, and only two responses were received. Prices from these contractors are:

So Florida Paving Group LLC d/b/a Charlie Frymyer, Inc.:	\$53,643.71
ABC Construction:	\$132,736.40

The department's consulting engineering firm Winingham & Fradley reviewed the proposals and recommends Charlie Frymyer Paving, Inc. The cost is a reasonable price for the proposed parking improvements at the plant.
