## **RESOLUTION NO. 2009 - 054**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SOUTHWEST RANCHES, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING A DONATION OF LIVE OAK TREES FROM GREENE TREE NURSERY FOR PLANTING BY THE TOWN ALONG THE HANCOCK ROAD RECREATIONAL TRAIL; BUDGETING FOR MAINTENANCE OF THE PLANTED TREES; APPROVING A BUDGET AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2008-2009 BUDGET FOR THIS PROJECT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS,** Southwest Ranches resident William Greene of Greene Tree Nursery has offered to donate live oak trees to the Town for beautification of the Hancock Road Recreational Trail between Old Sheridan Street and Luray Road; and

**WHEREAS,** the Central Broward Water Control District has agreed to accommodate the Town's request by allowing for the trees to be planted at 50 foot intervals 8 feet from the edge of through travel lane within their canal maintenance easement; and

**WHEREAS,** the design speed of Hancock Road has been reduced to 25 miles per hour, reducing the minimum clear zone requirement to 6 feet from edge of through travel lane in accordance with the Florida Department of Transportation's Manual of Uniform Minimum Standards for Design, Construction and Maintenance for Streets and Highways (Florida Greenbook); and

**WHEREAS,** at the Council's request, Staff has calculated the costs for installation and long term maintenance of the trees; and

**WHEREAS,** the donor has requested that the Town provide backfill to be spread by the donor at his property following removal of the trees; and

**WHEREAS,** the Town will plant the donated material and will purchase backfill to be used by the donor to fill holes left by the removed material; and

**WHEREAS,** funding for this project was not budgeted for within the fiscal year 2008-2009 budget; and

**WHEREAS,** the Town Administrator has identified \$11,477.00 in available funds within the Fund Balance Reserves that the Town can use to finance this project; and

**WHEREAS,** the Town Council is in support of the resident's donation in order to beautify the Hancock Road Recreational Trail; and

**WHEREAS,** the Town Council has determined that completion of this tree relocation project is in the best interest of the Town; and

**WHEREAS,** in order for the Town to take advantage of this opportunity, it is necessary to amend the fiscal year 2008-2009 budget by approving this budget amendment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Town Council of the Town of Southwest Ranches, Florida:

**Section 1.** The above referenced recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

**Section 2:** The Town Council of the Town of Southwest Ranches, Florida, hereby accepts the donation of 45 oak trees from Greene Tree Nursery for planting by the Town along the Hancock Road Recreational Trail.

**Section 3.** The Town Council hereby approves the following fiscal year 2008-2009 budget amendment:
