RESOLUTION NO. 2011-61

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SOUTHWEST RANCHES, FLORIDA APPROVING AN AMENDED CONCEPTUAL MASTER PLAN FOR COUNTRY ESTATES FISHING HOLE PARK; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, TOWN ADMINISTRATOR, AND TOWN ATTORNEY TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town received funding from the Broward County Land Preservation Bond Program and the Florida Communities Trust Florida Forever Program to acquire the Country Estates Fishing Hole property for the purpose of creating a public park with outdoor recreational amenities; and

WHEREAS, the Town acquired the property in November of 2004; and

WHEREAS, a conceptual Master Plan was approved by Resolution No. 2009-080 on September 3, 2009 detailing specific locations for proposed recreational amenities; and

WHEREAS, Designation of jurisdictional wetlands by the Broward County Development and Environmental Regulation Division (DERD) and The United States Army Corps of Engineers (US-ACOE) necessitates amendment of the Master Plan to relocate site amenities in order to avoid costly and time-intensive permitting processes; and

WHEREAS, the Town has been awarded funding from the Broward County Parks for People Program to develop playground, parking and landscaping improvements at the park; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution is necessary to identify locations for recreational amenities, to effectuate the intent of the Council and to ensure compliance with the Town's grant commitments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Southwest Ranches, Florida:

Section 1. The above-referenced recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. The Town Council hereby approves the Amended Conceptual Master Plan for Country Estates Fishing Hole Park, in substantially the same form as attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "A".

Section 3. The Town Council authorizes the Mayor, Town Administrator, and Town Attorney to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
