Call to order at 7:07pm. A quorum was established.

Debbie Green motioned to accept the minutes from January 13th, 2025. Selena Hodgers seconded, and the motion carried.

Discussion Items:

- Debbie Green gave the treasurer's report: \$35,950.75 is in the account.
- The Flamingo Flocking was successful with great support from the SWR Women's Group. We have four full flocks, and they will be stored in the trailer (and checked periodically).
- Per the 5K, volunteers are still needed. Priscilla will assist in reaching out to the schools. HOA will be asked for contributions. Uncle Louis will help supply 350 cones. Ed volunteers can help set up the cones.
- Barn Dance Notes: Debra will check the attendee list to verify who has and hasn't paid; 111 seats have been sold; 5-6 adult volunteers will help with the serving station and Gary will oversee; Gabby and Lisa Sullivan will handle the appetizers; volunteers will be at the barn MWF from 3-6 P.M.; we need name tags for the student volunteers; volunteers will man the trash, compost, and recycle stations; the kids will bus the tables; Outback is providing the meals and we will have salad & mac n cheese plus ice tea and lemonade at each table; we need 12 sternos; start serving at 7:45 P.M.; the food is to arrive at 6:30 P.M.; everyone who has paid has a seat;

Debbie Green brought prosecco and gin; ice is needed for the bar station plus, we need more coolers; Debra will confirm with Page on the arrival time for the food; the silent auction will conclude at 9 P.M.; the auction trailer will be parked in front of the driveway (will block barn conference area); Priscilla will bring a cowboy silhouette for décor; there are still lights left hanging from the recent quinces; the photobooth is in the décor room; the kids volunteering will wear black shirts with blue jeans; Maggie wants to create the centerpieces; the main decorating will occur Wednesday from 4-6 P.M. and Friday from 3-6 P.M.; Saturday will see the last five table set-ups at 5 P.M. via the volunteers; appetizers to begin at 7:15 P.M., then dinner at 7:45 P.M. followed by dancing until 11 P.M. and the silent auction closing at 9 P.M.; Kathy will make the chili for the chili station (includes sour cream, cheese Fritos, and onions); Kathy ordered 20 gallons of water and 10 bags of ice; who is getting the dessert cake?; Gary will arrange mosquito fogging; students will bring the pitchers, cups, and wrapped utensils to the tables; tables will include "thank you", numbers, and centerpieces;
