

BROWARD COUNTY, FL - The Public Works Department's Highway and Bridge Maintenance Division is on schedule with its structural reinforcement project of the bridge deck on Stirling Road just west of South Flamingo Road in Cooper City (see attached map). While a majority of the work has been performed underneath the bridge structure, it is now necessary to temporarily close travel lanes at this location for one night, to complete waterproofing and resurfacing. Both the eastbound and westbound lanes of Stirling Road at the intersection with South Flamingo Road will be closed beginning at 8PM on Wednesday, June 4, and are expected to re-open by 6AM on Thursday, June 5, 2025, barring any unforeseen conditions and/or weather delays.

During the closure, traffic traveling on Stirling Road will be detoured to Griffin Road while the northbound and southbound traffic lanes on South Flamingo Road will remain accessible. Emergency vehicle access through the intersection will be maintained at all times. Driveways and sidewalks in the area will also be accessible.

The Highway and Bridge Maintenance Division maintains and improves the County's highway/street system, operates drawbridges, and oversees mosquito control operations.
