

RESOLUTION NO. 2006 – 063

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SOUTHWEST RANCHES, FLORIDA INVITING THE CITY OF CLIFDEN, IRELAND TO BECOME A SISTER CITY OF THE TOWN OF SOUTHWEST RANCHES; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SEND AN INVITATION TO THE CITY OF CLIFDEN TO ENTER INTO A SISTER CITY AFFILIATION; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, TOWN ADMINISTRATOR AND TOWN ATTORNEY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF CLIFDEN TO ESTABLISH A SISTER CITY AFFILIATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Clifden, Ireland is located amidst the breathtaking mountain scenery and beautiful coastline of Ireland's western region known as Connemara; and

WHEARAS, Clifden's residents are renowned hosts with a flair for enjoying their surroundings and for helping others to do the same; and

WHEREAS, Clifden residents are generally deep-rooted in the community and its people are fiercely proud of their heritage and of their history; and

WHEREAS, Clifden is also proud of its substantial equestrian community and its numerous equine organizations including the Connemara Pony Association; and

WHEREAS, like the Town of Southwest Ranches, Clifden has sought to preserve its unique lifestyle; and

WHEREAS, the Sister City Program was created in 1956 to encourage greater friendship and understanding between the United States and other nations through direct personal contact; and

WHEARAS, in order to foster these goals cities throughout the world form partnerships to explore educational, economic, and cultural opportunities; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Southwest Ranches desires to form an affiliation with Clifden to develop a mutual understanding of both municipalities through the exchange of various information and materials; and

WHEREAS, through this affiliation the Town encourages its residents to visit Clifden to identify themes common to both municipalities and to create new initiatives to further the relationship between the municipalities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Southwest Ranches, Florida:

Section 1: The above referenced recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: The Town Council of the Town of Southwest Ranches hereby invites the City of Clifden, Ireland to become a Sister City of the Town of Southwest Ranches.

Section 3: The Town Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to send an invitation to the City of Clifden, in substantially the same form as that attached hereto as Exhibit "A", to enter into a Sister City affiliation.

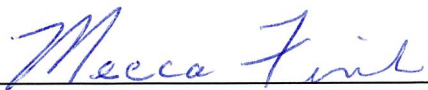
Section 4: The Town Council hereby authorizes the Mayor, Town Administrator and Town Attorney to enter into a Sister City Agreement in substantially the same form as that attached hereto as Exhibit "B" and to make such modifications, additions and/or deletions which they deem necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Section 5: This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

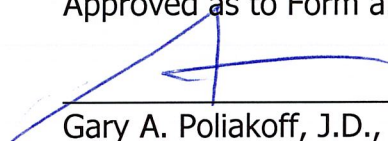

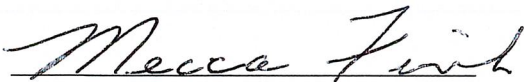
**AN AGREEMENT FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF

- Identify themes, common to both, that can generate new initiatives to further and nurture the increasingly powerful financial, social and cultural relationships between the municipalities;

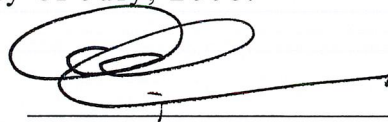

This Agreement will go into effect this 28 day of July, 2006.



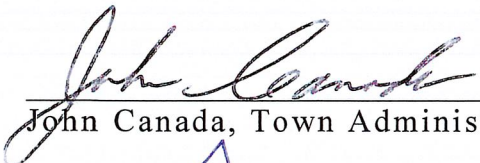
