

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-060

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF SOUTHWEST RANCHES, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ASSIGNMENT OF THE TOWN'S PRIMARY DISASTER AND DEBRIS MANAGEMENT CONTRACTOR AGREEMENT FOR EMERGENCY DEBRIS REMOVAL AND EMERGENCY LOGISTICAL SERVICES FROM BERGERON EMERGENCY SERVICES, INC. TO EDS HOLDCO, LLC D/B/A BERGERON EMERGENCY SERVICES; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, THE TOWN ADMINISTRATOR, AND THE TOWN ATTORNEY TO EXECUTE AN ASSIGNMENT, IF NECESSARY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 2025-060 and RFP No. 25-10 for Disaster Debris Removal and Emergency Logistical Services, the Town entered into an Agreement with Bergeron Emergency Services, Inc. ("Bergeron") to serve as the Town's primary disaster and debris management contractor; and

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2026, Bergeron sold its assets to EDS HOLDCO, LLC d/b/a Bergeron Emergency Services; and

WHEREAS, Bergeron has requested that the Agreement be assigned to EDS HOLDCO, LLC d/b/a Bergeron Emergency Services, and EDS HOLDCO, LLC d/b/a Bergeron Emergency Services has agreed to assume all rights, duties, obligations, liabilities, and responsibilities of Bergeron under the Agreement, subject to the Town's consent; and

WHEREAS, upon the effective date of the Assignment, Bergeron shall cease to be a party to the Agreement, and EDS HOLDCO, LLC d/b/a Bergeron Emergency Services shall succeed to Bergeron's rights and assume Bergeron's obligations under the Agreement without modification to its terms; and

WHEREAS, the Town will experience no interruption or reduction in the services required under the Agreement as a result of the Assignment, and EDS HOLDCO, LLC d/b/a Bergeron Emergency Services shall continue to perform in accordance with all existing terms, conditions, specifications, warranties, obligations, and requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to approve the Assignment of the Agreement to EDS HOLDCO, LLC d/b/a Bergeron Emergency Services which shall continue under the same terms through its expiration date of April 2, 2028, with the Town Administrator's option to extend the contract for up to two (2) additional two-year periods, subject to mutual agreement and satisfactory performance.

WHEREAS, the Assignment does not alter the scope of work, pricing, insurance requirements, or any other material term of the Agreement, and the Town Council finds that approving the Assignment is in the best interest of the Town

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SOUTHWEST RANCHES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The above-referenced recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The Town Council hereby approves the Assignment of the Town's primary disaster and debris management contractor Agreement from Bergeron Emergency Services, Inc. to EDS HOLDCO, LLC d/b/a Bergeron Emergency Services.

Section 3. The Town Council hereby authorizes the Mayor, the Town Administrator, and the Town Attorney to execute the Assignment, if necessary, and to take all other actions consistent with this Resolution.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

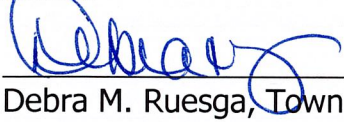

CONSENT TO ASSIGNMENT
OF THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE TOWN OF SOUTHWEST RANCHES
AND BERGERON EMERGENCY SERVICES
TO EDS HOLDCO, LLC d/b/a
BERGERON EMERGENCY SERVICES

THIS CONSENT TO ASSIGNMENT (this "Assignment"), executed this 23 day of July, 2026, is made a part of the Agreement entitled "Disaster Debris Removal and Emergency Logistical Services", approved by Resolution No. 2025-060 (the "Agreement"), together with any amendments thereto, attached hereto as Attachment "A", by and among **Bergeron Emergency Services, Inc.** whose Federal Identification No. is 65-1274968 ("Bergeron"), and the **Town of Southwest Ranches** ("Town"), for the purpose of memorializing the consent of the Town to the assignment by Bergeron of all of its right, title, and interest in and to the Agreement to **EDS HOLDCO, LLC d/b/a Bergeron Emergency Services** whose Federal Identification No. is 81-1060739, and the assumption by EDS HOLDCO, LLC d/b/a Bergeron Emergency Services of all obligations of Bergeron under the Agreement. Terms used but not otherwise defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Agreement.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Town and Bergeron are parties the Agreement entitled "Disaster Debris Removal and Emergency Logistical Services", approved by Resolution No. 2025-060, pursuant to which Bergeron provides emergency debris management and related services to the Town; and

WHEREAS, Bergeron has requested that the Agreement be assigned to EDS HOLDCO, LLC d/b/a Bergeron Emergency Services, and EDS HOLDCO, LLC d/b/a Bergeron Emergency Services has agreed to assume all rights, duties, obligations, liabilities, and responsibilities of Bergeron under the Agreement, subject to the Town's consent; and

WHEREAS, upon the effective date of this Assignment, Bergeron shall cease to be a party to the Agreement, and EDS HOLDCO, LLC d/b/a Bergeron Emergency Services shall succeed to Bergeron's rights and assume Bergeron's obligations under the Agreement without modification of its terms; and

WHEREAS, the Town will experience no interruption or reduction in the services required under the Agreement as a result of this Assignment, and EDS HOLDCO, LLC d/b/a Bergeron Emergency Services shall perform the Agreement in accordance with all existing terms, conditions, specifications, warranties, obligations, and requirements thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing recitals and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. CONSENT. The Town hereby consents to the assignment by Bergeron of all of its right, title, and interest in and to the Agreement to EDS HOLDCO, LLC d/b/a Bergeron Emergency Services. EDS HOLDCO, LLC d/b/a Bergeron Emergency Services hereby accepts such assignment and assumes all obligations, liabilities, duties, and responsibilities of Bergeron arising under the Agreement from and after the effective date of this Assignment.

2. PAYMENT. From and after the effective date of this Assignment, all payments due under the Agreement shall be made to EDS HOLDCO, LLC d/b/a Bergeron Emergency Services.

3. OTHER PROVISIONS REMAIN IN EFFECT. Except as expressly provided herein, all terms and conditions of the original Agreement between the parties dated June 12, 2026, shall remain in full force and effect. All references in the Agreement to Bergeron Emergency Services shall, from and after the effective date of this Assignment, be deemed to refer to EDS HOLDCO, LLC d/b/a Bergeron Emergency Services, where applicable.

4. NO WAIVER. Nothing contained in this Assignment shall be construed as a waiver of any rights, remedies, defenses, warranties, or obligations available to the Town under the Agreement or applicable law.

5. CONFLICTING PROVISIONS. In the event of any conflict between the terms of this Assignment and the Agreement, the terms of this Assignment shall control solely with respect to the assignment and assumption of the Agreement. In all other respects, the Agreement shall remain unchanged.

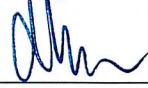

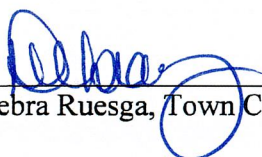

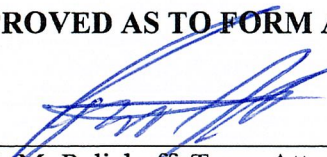
