Broward JIC Snapshot #27: Vaccine is HERE for Children Age 12-15

KEY TAKEAWAYS

- Effective today, May 13, all Florida Department of Health in Broward (DOH-Broward) and multiple other vaccination sites in Broward County dispensing Pfizer vaccine have expanded their operations to include children age 12-15. <u>Vaccination Site Locations</u>
- This expansion is critical to our community's efforts to end the pandemic. The Food and Drug
 Administration authorized use of the Pfizer vaccine for 12- to 15-year-olds, and the Centers for
 Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) subsequently adopted a recommendation from the Advisory
 Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) endorsing the safety and effectiveness of the vaccine for
 use in individuals age 12+.
- DOH-Broward and vaccination partners including hospitals and state-sponsored sites were prepared and moved immediately to open up operations under the new guidelines.

NINE NEW "POP-UP" VACCINATION SITES FOR MAY

DOH-Broward announced that in addition to expanding hours at several of the nine fixed public vaccination sites to accommodate residents with various work schedules (see Snapshot #26 for a refresher), there are nine new "pop-up" vaccination sites opening in May, identified in collaboration with municipalities and cultural organizations offering public events. They are open to the public, age 12+, with no appointment required:

OTHER NEWS

- The partnership between DOH-Broward, Broward County Public Schools and participating charter schools will complete the first dose vaccinations in high schools tomorrow. At this point, 55% of Broward County residents age 16 and over have received at least one dose of vaccine.
- Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) has announced that the C.B. Smith Park test collection site, our County's largest, will close permanently on Friday, May 28, 2021. Several <u>test</u> collection site locations remain for the convenience of our residents.
