Broward JIC Snapshot #31: Pop-Ups Proliferate in June

Sixty-one percent of Broward residents age 12 and over have received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine.

MASS VACCINATION SITES CONTINUE; BUT CHANGES AHEAD

There are currently 12 fixed vaccination site locations in Broward County. Nine of the sites are operated by DOH-Broward; three are operated by Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM). Schedule updates you should be aware of:

- FDEM has announced that effective June 18, 2021, their two vaccination sites at Broward College North Campus (Coconut Creek) and Vizcaya Park (Miramar) will close. Until then, they will dispense second dose shots only of Pfizer (Vizcaya) or Moderna (Broward College) and shots of the single-dose Johnson & Johnson vaccine (both locations) from 9AM – 5PM, seven days a week.
- DOH-Broward has announced that Tree Tops Park site in Davie will close on *June 17, 2021*, the sites at Snyder Park in Fort Lauderdale will close on *June 18, 2021*, and the site at Pompano Beach CitiCentre will close on *June 30, 2021*.

21 NEW POP-UP VACCINATION SITES ANNOUNCED FOR JUNE

In recognition of the shift in public demand for vaccine, Florida Department of Health in Broward (DOH-Broward), in partnership with municipalities, announced 21 "pop-up" vaccination sites in June, to help reach those who remain vaccine-hesitant. Please promote these dates, times and locations in your respective municipalities. DOH-Broward staff are on hand to provide information as well as vaccinate. DOH-Broward popup sites offer Pfizer vaccine to residents ages 12 and older. No appointment required. No insurance necessary. DOH-Broward pop-up sites offer \$10 grocery gift certificates redeemable at local supermarkets for all individuals receiving first doses.
