Regular Meeting of the Town Council of Southwest Ranches was held at 13400 Griffin Road in the Southwest Ranches Council Chambers. The meeting, having been properly noticed, was called to order by Vice Mayor Breitkreuz at 7:05 PM. Attendance was noted by roll call and was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

- **3. Presentation** Recognition of the Archbishop McCarthy Baseball Team was postponed to the last meeting in August.
- **4. Public Comment** The following members of the public addressed the Town Council: Vince Falletta, Ruth Wolff, Mary Gay Chaples, and Newell Hollingsworth.
- **5. Board Reports** There were none at this time.

6. Council Member Comments

Council Member Fisikelli addressed some of the public comments on bulk pick-up.

Vice Mayor Breitkreuz also addressed the bulk issues. He also requested the Town Administrator to look into having FDOT coordinate a better flow for traffic at the new light on Griffin Road for I-75 Southbound ramp. He stated that he will be coordinating with the Town Administrator for a workshop on traffic on 185th Avenue and 190th Avenue in September.

7. Legal Comments

The Town Attorney provided an update on Pop's Gun Range court case. He also stated that he has received phone calls of whether or not the homeowner has the liability if a horse slips and falls on a driveway and injures the rider; he stated that it is not the homeowners responsibility because riding a horse is considered a dangerous activity and a rider is at his/her own risk.

8. Administration Comments

The Town Administrator reported that Town Hall will have a paddock for horse riders that visit. He also provided an update on the bulk waste pick-up issues.

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9. Resolution — A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SOUTHWEST RANCHES, FLORIDA APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH BEJAR CONSTRUCTION INC.
