## **RESOLUTION 2017-064**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SOUTHWEST RANCHES, FLORIDA, RATIFYING THE TOWN ADMINISTRATOR'S EXECUTION OF THE THIRD MODIFICATION TO THE AGREEMENT WITH A SUPERIOR TOWING, INC., FOR POST STORM DISASTER TOWING AND WRECKING SERVICES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS,** on May 7<sup>th</sup>, 2009, pursuant to Resolution No. 2009-062, the Town Council approved an Agreement with A Superior Towing Company to provide wrecker and towing services to the Town; and

WHEREAS, the initial Agreement expired on May 22, 2012; and

**WHEREAS,** on May 24<sup>th</sup>,2012, pursuant to Resolution No. 2012-053, the Town Council approved the First Modification to the Agreement, which extended the Agreement for an additional three year term, which expired on May 21, 2015; and

**WHEREAS,** on May 28<sup>th</sup>, 2015, pursuant to Resolution No. 2015-051, the Town Council approved the Second Modification to the Agreement, which extended contractor's term and increased the Town's rate for the contractor's services; and

**WHEREAS,** on September 4, 2017, as a result of Hurricane Irma, Governor Scott issued a State of Emergency; and

**WHEREAS,** on September 7, 2017, the Town of Southwest Ranches issued its own State of Emergency as a result of Hurricane Irma; and

**WHEREAS,** recognizing that the Town of Southwest Ranches may need post disaster towing and wrecker services, the Town Administrator, using his state of emergency executive powers, amended contractor's agreement to ensure that contractor will be able to provide post disaster relief; and

**WHEREAS,** this Resolution seeks the Town Council's ratification of the Third Modification to the Agreement;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Town Council of the Town of Southwest Ranches, Florida:

**Section 1:** Recitals. The recitals above are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

<u>Section 2: Authorization.</u> The Town Council hereby ratifies the Third Modification to the Agreement with A Superior Towing, Inc., in substantially the same form as that attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

**Section 3:** Approval. The Town Council hereby ratifies the authority of the Town Administrator's authority to enter into the Third Modification to the Agreement in substantially the same form as that attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and to make such modifications, additions, and/or deletions, which they deem necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

**Section 4:** Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

## THIRD MODIFICATION TO THE AGREEMENT

THIS IS THE THIRD MODIFICATION TO THE AGREEMENT entered into as of this 7<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2017, between the Town of Southwest Ranches, a municipal corporation of the State of Florida (the "Town") and A Superior Towing ("A Superior"), a Florida corporation, for the purposes of amending the Agreement between the Town and A Superior, dated May 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2009.

## **WITNESSETH:**

**WHEREAS**, on May 7<sup>th</sup>, 2009, pursuant to Resolution No. 2009-062, the Town Council approved an Agreement with A Superior Towing Company to provide wrecker and towing services to the Town; and

WHEREAS, the initial Agreement expired on May 22, 2012; and

**WHEREAS,** on May 24<sup>th</sup>,2012, pursuant to Resolution No. 2012-053, the Town Council approved the First Modification to the Agreement, which extended the Agreement for an additional three year term, which expired on May 21, 2015; and

**WHEREAS,** on May 28<sup>th</sup>, 2015, pursuant to Resolution No. 2015-051, the Town Council approved the Second Modification to the Agreement, which extended contractor's term and increased the Town's rate for the contractor's services; and

**WHEREAS,** on September 4, 2017, as a result of Hurricane Irma, Governor Scott issued a State of Emergency; and

**WHEREAS,** on September 7, 2017, the Town of Southwest Ranches issued its own State of Emergency as a result of Hurricane Irma; and

**WHEREAS,** recognizing that the Town of Southwest Ranches may need post disaster towing and wrecker services, the Town Administrator desires to amend contractor's agreement to ensure that contractor will be able to provide post disaster relief;

**NOW THEREFORE,** for and in consideration of the premises and for Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and for other good and valuable consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree that the Original Agreement shall be amended as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct, and are incorporated

herein by reference.

2. A Section entitled "Post Disaster Relief Services" shall be added to read as follows:

## **POST DISASTER RELIEF SERVICES:**

CONTRACTOR shall be authorized to provide all necessary post disaster relief services required by the Town, and as directed by the Town Administrator or by his designee. CONTRACTOR shall keep detailed reports, records, and invoices of all post disaster relief services provided, and shall provide them in a form and format necessary for the Town to receive FEMA reimbursement for same. CONTRACTOR agrees that its fee for such post disaster relief services shall be limited to the amount reimbursed by FEMA, and that it may not look to the Town for additional payment.
